

OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: 59/OFF/100/2020

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **CHATEAU DELICE LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **48 Chandler Way, Rolleston** and known as "**CHATEAU DELICE LIMITED**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS – SECTION 116 (2)

- (a) No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day or contrary to sections 49 or 59 (1) of the Act.
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold and supplied on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday from 9.00am to 9.00pm

- (d) The licensee must take steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
- (e) The following step must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
- Alcohol must only be sold and supplied from within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

ENDORSEMENT – SECTION 40

- (f) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on any receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
- The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
 - A legible image of the licence, or clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- (g) The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
- In the case of an order made using an internet site the prospective buyer must declare by ticking an on-screen box, that he or she is 18 years of age (and where the prospective receiver is involved, that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) –
 - Once, when the prospective buyer first enters the internet site; and
 - Again, immediately before the sale of any alcohol is completed.
- (h) In the case of any internet form, telephone order or physical order form, unless the prospective buyer has by declaring, or ticking or by signing the relevant age delcarations that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where any prospective receiver is involved, has declared, ticked or signed that the prospective receiver is 18 years of age or over), the procedure is to refuse to sell alcohol to that prospective buyer.
- (i) The following step must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
- The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in their Host Responsibility Policy aimed at promoting the reasonable consumption of alcohol.
- (j) No direct sales may be made from the premises.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Section 59 – Requirements relating to remote sales by holders of off-licences
Section 214 – Manager to be on duty at all times and responsible for compliance
Section 215 – Circumstances where section 214 does not apply (for remote sales)

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises situated at 48 Chandler Way, Rolleston are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee on the 30th day of March 2020.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Chandler Way, Rolleston is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
- until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either -
- until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements above, **the licence expires on the 10th of day May 2023**, unless again renewed.

NOTE: This licence replaces licence number 59/OFF/035/2017 issued by the Selwyn District Licensing Committee.
